A group counseling session of class 10 and 12 on career counselling was organized by EY Foundation.




Mobile IT Lab






WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM









With the support of Rural Self Employment
Training Institutes (RSETI) Bulandshahr, we
inaugurated a ten-day goat-rearing training
program to enhance the livelihood
opportunities for our SHG women at
Chhapera Nagala village.
