



PPES hosted a science exhibition with 45 students of grades 11th & 12th. It aimed to boost their self-confidence and motivation through innovative and self-designed projects. These projects showcased scientific skills, encouraged creativity, and sparked curiosity in students.

Also, under our STEM program, students work on various projects such as curating automatic street light, laser home security, moisture detection device, smart dustbin, windmill, water dispenser, and rain drop sensory.



After a three-year hiatus, we are thrilled to announce that PPES organised the 7th edition of Annual Half Marathon on August 27, 2023. This yearly event solidified our unwavering commitment to empowering rural girls.

The event featured three categories of runs: Half Marathon, 10KM, and 5KM, attracting participants from various backgrounds.

The chief guest was **Ms. Meenal Kotak**, a Chartered Accountant and accomplished ultramarathoner, holding records of 379 Kms in 72 hours run in the US. She is also the first Indian female to cross 100 miles in 24 hours.

With over **4000+ participants**, including students from more than **25 schools**, notable sports personalities like Mr. Badal Teotia, along with Ms. Anvita Upadhyay, Circle Officer (CO), Anupshahr. The event brought together a diverse group of individuals, all running for a meaningful cause.

Prana Health Centre Updates

- The Centre treated 3280+ patients in this quarter
- 1424 girls received Hepatitis-B vaccination
- Blood test of 830 girls were conducted
- ENT check up of 515 girls and Skin (derma) checkup for 101 girls were done. The check-ups were done by PPES long term supporters Dr. Rajesh Dhir (Senior ENT specialist) and Dr. Monika Dhir (dermatologist).

Other Updates

- 37 students participated in the enrollment process for NCC cadets in which 25 students from 9th grade were selected
- A menstrual hygiene session was conducted for 321 students from 9th, 10th & 12th grades and awareness session on usage of menstrual cups was organized for 98 students for 11th & 12th grades
- Session on anemia, nutrition, personal and oral hygiene, wellness, learning about organs, menstruation and sexual reproductive health were organised under the health club
- Celebrations- Hindi Diwas, Teacher's Day, Grandparents Day, Youth Skill Day & Independence Day were celebrated at school
- A session on 'good and bad touch' was organised for 631 students of 6th, 8th, and 9th grades
- Sunday sports activities with 50+ girls participating every week
