

Poultry Training for Self-Help Group Women



Mission Shakti Training Program for Self-Help Group Women



A one-day training session was organized on Backyard Poultry Farm (BYP). It was attended by BYP enthusiasts, program team members and government veterinary officers. The programme aims to empower women through family-based poultry and encourage them to adopt BYP as an enterprise.

A six-day Mission Shakti training program was organised with 150 participants from Self-Help Groups. Under the Mission Shakti, women are empowered for safety, security, and self-reliance.

Prana Health Centre Updates





- ENT preliminary examinations for 3000+ girls
- 3134 patients were treated
- Hemoglobin tests for 200 girls
- Tetanus vaccinations for 31 students
- Health education classes were conducted on topics related to oral hygiene, personal hygiene, and ENT



Economic Empowerment-iVillage



- iVillage has joined hands with IIM Bangalore as their key partner for sustainability initiatives.
- iVillage participated in the Blind School Mela Exhibition in Delhi. Along with community engagement, it was a great platform to showcase products made by rural women.
