EDUCATION UPDATES

School Exchange Program

Online sessions were conducted with Oxford, Sheffield, and Putney High School in the UK under the school exchange program.

The sessions provided the students with an opportunity to explore various activities conducted in schools and to learn about different cultures. This program was attended by students from 9th to 11th grade.

The admission process has started for the academic session 2024-25. This academic year, we will be adding 500+ more girls to our school, bringing the total strength to 3500+ students.

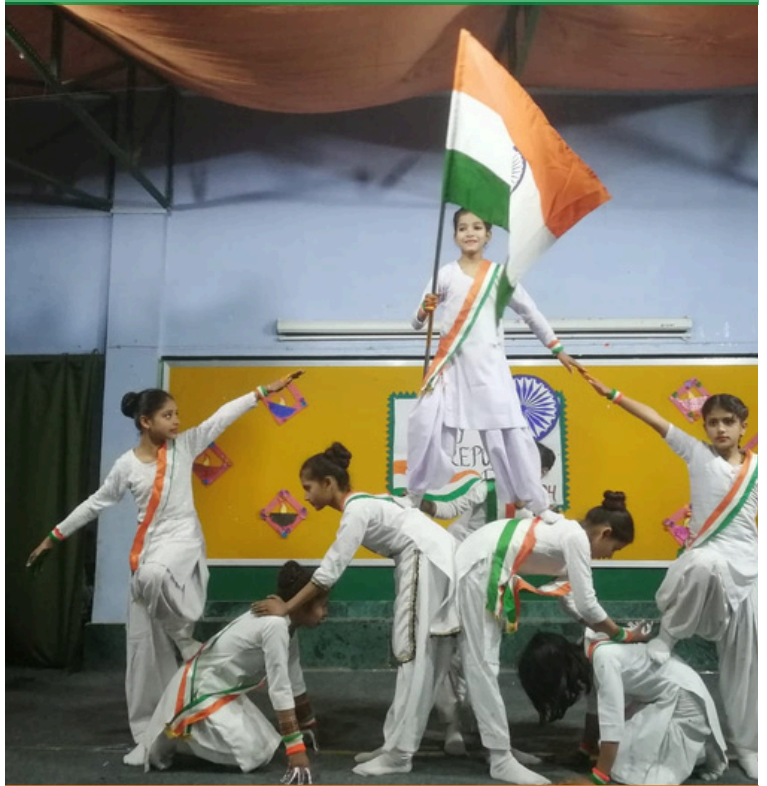
EVENTS & CELEBRATIONS

HEALTH & HYGIENE

Prana Health Centre Updates

- Treated 3215 patients
- Hemoglobin tests for 220 students
- Provided HPV vaccinations to 3 girls
- Hepatitis-B booster vaccinations to 620 students
- Conducted multiple health education classes, addressing topics including personal hygiene, oral hygiene, and BMI
- Conducted blood group tests for more than 75 students



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIVISION (CDD)



Animal Treatment Vaccination Camp

PPES organized two animal treatment, Peste des Ruminants (PPR), and Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) vaccination camps in collaboration with the veterinary department, government of the Uttar Pradesh, to ensure the health of livestock in Ahar village of Anupshahr block and Ghosipura village of Dibai block, benefiting 413 animals.

CDD Other Achievements



- Provided bookkeeping refresher training to 198 bookkeepers
- Facilitated 250 SHG Farmers in wheat sowing and trained them in INM & Integrated Pest Management (IPM)
- Facilitated the convergence of 10 SHG members with the Prime Minister Awas Yojana under the housing scheme
- Facilitated the processing of death claims for 2 SHG members
- Conducted Integrated Animal Management Practices (IAMP) training post-test with 50 SHG farmers
- Identified 282 farmers for vegetable cultivation
- Facilitated the enterprise development and opened 53 enterprises such as the Kirana shop by SHG women
- Developed 2 backyard kitchen gardens
