'Traitor' to Trailblazer: The Story of Chanchal



They called her a "traitor" for choosing books over house chores and travelling 30km daily "just to get educated". Relatives mocked her ambition, but at Pardada Pardadi, she found her place - a world of computers and courage.

She was criticised by her relatives and villagers for being a useless child who had chosen to prioritise studying. She didn't just study, she fought for her education. In fact, not only for herself, but also for her sister.

Once her family saw her incredible growth, she convinced her father to educate her elder sister as well, who was about to be married.

Her hard work paid off, and she cracked an opportunity at HCL, where she currently works as a Senior Specialist (Software Engineer).

"Today, instead of limiting my dreams, I stand as a financial pillar of my family."

She recalls that if she had not gone against societal expectations, she might have been married early and forced to give up her dreams.

However, today, she is a crucial financial pillar of her family. She now supports her siblings' education and contributes significantly to her family's financial stability.

Chanchal dreams of one day helping children and giving back to her community. When asked if she has advice for the younger girls, she said, "Don't be afraid, face the fear, put your capabilities to use... and the sky shall be all yours."

Five of our alumni, currently studying at Swarnim Gujarat Sports University, Vadodara, volunteered at the Women's Premier League (WPL).



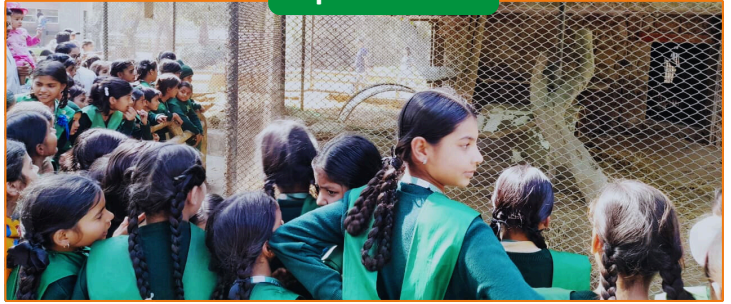

Chick Vaccination to Strengthen Backyard Poultry



1,410 chicks were vaccinated for Ranikhet Disease (RD), Infectious Bursal Disease (IBD), and RD Booster across villages under the project supported by Sahara Means Support and Shivia, strengthening backyard poultry enterprises.

Mega Health Camp



1,932 community members were supported through a mega health camp in 9 villages (527 men, 980 women, and 425 children) under the project supported by ICF.



Animal Vaccination Drive

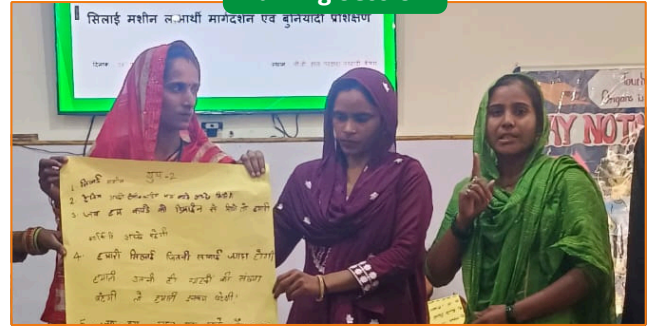
146 livestock belonging to 53 families were vaccinated against Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) in Gram Panchayat Gangapur, protecting rural livelihoods.

Nursery Visits and Training



70 women farmers were trained on the use of organic fertilizers to treat yellowing leaves and strengthen plant stems, along with an explanation of the benefits of Jeevamrut.

A one-day orientation and training session on tailoring was organised for 91 identified women under the project supported by Zimmer Biomet.
